## The challenge

- Use some or all of the numbered tiles available to hit the target.
- Use some or all of the four standard operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) to hit the target.


## Scoring

- 10 points are awarded for correctly getting the target number.
- 7 points are awarded for getting a number that is 1 to 5 below or above the target number.
- 5 points are awarded for getting a number that is 6 to 10 below or above the target number.
- 5 extra points are awarded for finding two different methods (ways) to hit the target number.


## Rules

- Concatenation of the digits is not allowed: you can't use a " 9 " and " 9 " to make " 99 ".
- You cannot create a negative number or fraction as one of the steps to getting to the target number.
- Each numbered tile can only be used once in the calculation, but you do not need to use all of the tiles.
- You can use the operations more than once if you want to.


## Method

- Write the target number in the first box.
- Write the numbers in the six empty tiles.
- Show your working so that each step is recorded neatly on a separate line.
