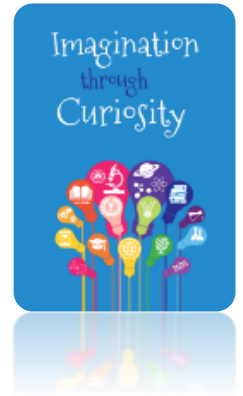

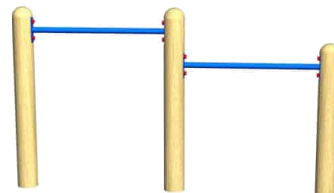
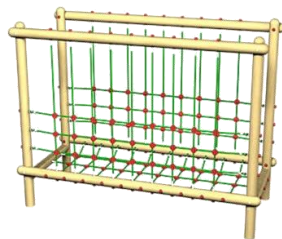
We also had the final Full Governing Body meeting of this academic year and it was super to welcome our two new parent governors.
