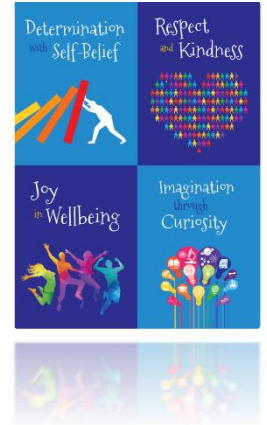

Further to previous correspondence this is a reminder that the NHS School Immunisation Team will be coming in to Claremont on **13th September 2024** to administer the nasal flu vaccination to all children from Reception to Year 6.
