

Curriculum

In **Art**, the children will be learning different printing techniques.

In **English**, linked to Create, we will be using a wordless picture book, and later, paintings by master artists, to inspire our writing and explore the question 'Can a picture tell a story?'. We will continue to focus on using a range of punctuation and vocabulary accurately, building it into well-planned stories. We will also be looking at different ways to start stories.

In **Science**, we will be learning about how plants grow and reproduce.

In **Design and Technology**, we will be exploring sewing skills with the aim of making a purse or wallet.

In **Music**, we will be composing our own short pieces and performing these as part of an ensemble. We will also be analysing a range of musical styles and traditions.

In **French**, the children will be improving their conversational skills and vocabulary.

PSHE

In PSHE, the children will be exploring the big question 'Why should we eat well and look after our teeth?'
