

## DT

In Term 5, pupils will design and then make an electrical buzzer game, using their knowledge of circuits in Science to help them.

In Term 6, the children will be designing and creating their own picture book with moving images. Their target audience will be Year 1 and we will share the books with Ash and Elm class. The children will evaluate current children's picture books and explore different levers and linkages, before planning and designing their own picture book.

## Art

The children will explore textural art using various paper skills, such as ripping, curling, quilling and twisting. The children will apply these skills to create a three-dimensional scene from a well-known book.

## Music

The children will continue to receive their ukulele tuition for the remainder of the year.

Alongside ukuleles, pupils will also be exploring Prokofiev's 'Peter & the Wolf' (linked to English). They will analyse the piece and move towards working in groups to compose their own piece.
