

Theme

During terms 1 and 2, we will be learning about **The Great Fire of London** to help us answer the big question, **‘Do all changes improve our lives?’**

In **history**, we will be developing the historical skills of chronology, enquiry, knowledge and interpretation.

In **science**, we will be finding out about the characteristics and uses of everyday materials.

In **computing**, we will be learning about what IT is, as well as some basic programming skills.

In **music**, we will be studying London-themed songs, as well as music and instrumentation dating back to Tudor times.

In **RE**, we will be exploring the following questions: ‘How should we care for others and the world?’ and ‘Why does it matter?’

In **PSHE**, we will be focusing on the following questions: ‘What helps us to stay safe?’ and ‘How do we recognise our feelings?’

In **DT**, we will be creating Tudor carts using axels and wheels.

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling

In terms 1 and 2, we will focus on character descriptions, recounts, diaries, poetry, letter writing, handwriting and the following GPS (grammar, punctuation and spelling):

- Common exception words (tricky words)
- Letter formation
- Full stops and capital letters
- Word classes (nouns, verbs and adjectives)
- Coordinating conjunctions
- Question marks and exclamation marks

Mathematics

- Number and place value
- Addition
- Subtraction
- Properties of shapes

All of our maths lessons will include opportunities to explore problem solving, reasoning and fluency.
